ICS₂ Data Requirements



Carrier Details

Party Information



For accompanied loads, the carrier is the haulier, for unaccompanied loads, it will be the shipping line. The following details are required:

- **Name and address**
- **EU or XI EORI number** – if the carrier does not have an EU/XI EORI number, they must register for one.
- **Consignor and Consignee details** - Full address and EORI numbers are required for both parties.
- **Seller and Buyer details** - Full address and EORI numbers are required for Seller/Buyers when they are different to the Consignee/Consignor

Who is involved in the movement

| | Carrier | Consignor | Consignee | Seller | Buyer |

| EORI | Mandatory | Not Required | Mandatory | Not Required | Required if this information is different to the Consignee |



What the goods are

Goods Information

Commodity codes must be a minimum of 6 digits, and goods descriptions must be clear, specific and detailed. Vague/generic descriptions such as “meat”, “supermarket goods”, “spare parts” will not be allowed.


- ✓ HS code to a minimum of 6 digits
- ✓ Accurate goods description (Must not be generic words such as 'spare parts' or 'vegetables' find list of stop words below)
- ✓ Gross Weights per item
- ✓ Packaging information per item
- ✓ CUS Code (for applicable chemicals)
- ✓ UN Dangerous Goods Note (if applicable)

How the goods are moving

Transport Information



For accompanied movements (driver travels with the vehicle)

- Vehicle registration number & Vehicle nationality
- Place of loading & Place of unloading.

For unaccompanied movements

- Trailer or container number & nationality
- Place of Loading / Unloading (the port of arrival and port of departure).

Mandatory transport information for all movements

- Active Transport Details (ship IMO or train number, depending on mode of transport) and nationality
- Port of exit from GB, and date and time of departure
- Port of entry to the EU, and date and time of arrival
- Countries of routing.
